

## VBS 2014 teams

1. crafts: plan preschool **and** elementary daily crafts, request supplies from congregation or purchase them, sort supplies in paper grocery bags as they come in by day and grade, write instructions in advance so youth can prep during VBS, make samples
2. photography: take individual learner pictures with church camera and get them developed first and second day, take candid during week
3. church-wide decorating: plan decorations, especially Worship Center; request supplies from congregation or purchase them and sort as they come in; decorate and set up the Sat. and Sun. before VBS starts
4. family day cookout on Friday 7/25: help prepare paper bag lunches for 500 on 7/25
5. ice cream social kickoff at field behind church on Sunday, July 13: plan and purchase supplies (need 25 Bridger "scoopers"; Bridger families to bring enough ice cream for their family plus one more person and ice cream scoop; tables, bowls, spoons, napkins, cups, water coolers; pens and clipboards; trash cans; folks to teach skills such as soccer, football, cheerleading) to kids; handouts for parents (info to be determined)
6. medical: CPR-certified adults, nurse
7. security: ensure all who enter WC are wearing wristbands and those who leave are not
8. worship rally (9 a.m. and 11:50 a.m.): large group leader to excite the kids, do short skits, make announcements
9. greeters, door openers and "directors" (direct folks to new registration, preregistered sign in, preschool registration)
10. prayer
11. salvation: talk to/pray with learners during VBS day who answer salvation call

12. follow-up bread ministry the week after VBS: for VBS families who indicate they have no church home--need people to map directions and deliver loaves

13. clean up: on Friday starting at 12:45 p.m. because the entire church has to look as if VBS never happened

14. publicity: make signs for inside church building, signs for registration and all rotation stations (crafts, music, etc.); man registration table Sunday mornings ("cheat sheet" provided); ask adult BF classes to provide snacks and drinks for adult volunteers

15. volunteer appreciation: provide one or two small tokens of appreciation for volunteers (one team for adults, including office staff, and one team for youth volunteers)
